c. There will be a retiring collection for the Holy Places at the Good Friday Services

The Congregation for Oriental Churches has raised an awareness of the plight of Christians in the Holy Land. They say that during the past year, 'the Christians of those lands suffered an isolation that made them feel even more distant, cut off from vital contact with the brethren from various countries of the world. They have also suffered the loss of work, due to the absence of pilgrims, and the consequent difficulty in living with dignity and providing for their families and children.

Without support it will be difficult for many of them to resist the temptation to leave their country, more demanding to support the parishes in their pastoral and educational work and harder to sustain the social commitment to the poor and suffering'.

The Congregation is appealing to the Universal Church to support the small Christian community that lives in the Middle East and the upkeep of the Holy Places.
